


CAPTAIN'S LOG, STARDATE 7607.23

While conducting a routine mapping mission in the constellation of Carina, an event has occured that threatens the very existence of the Galactic Federation. Through what Mr. Spock calls a random dissolution of normal space - time as a result of ion storms (and what Doctor McCoy calls a rip in the fabric of creation), a number of humanoids have materialized on the bridge of the Enterprise. They are a primitive lot, some with false teeth, ocular prostheses, and one missing appendix. Dr. McCoy is appalled at their general state of unhealthiness, but I have confidence that he will be able to put them right again. However, their physical condition is the least of our worries. It is the story they tell that has brought about the crisis that we presently face. They claim to be from a parallel universe in which we - all of us aboard the Enterprise are characters in a "television show" in the mid twentieth century (old earth time). Otherwise, the hardy band of freethinkers --those who do not worship the "Nielsons" --will be condemned to watching reruns of hypnotic horrors called "The Space Lost", "The Space Family Robinson", "Space: On And On", or some such terrifying mind rotting spectacle. Although the Prime Directive forbids interference with a naturally evolving culture, we feel that any life form that is a slave to these insidious "Nielsons" is in need of whatever help we have to offer.

Strangely enough, the success of our mission and the future of the Federation depends on the success of the ritual. So wish us luck. If we play our hunches and combine Vulcan logic with human intuition, I am confident that everybody will have a fine time, we will be able to return to our rightful place, and the two worlds will be safe. The only thing that bothers me is the object of their worship. Mr. Spock assures me that it is most illogical to expect the Deity to take the form of a large, galactic-inhabitating fowl. Makes you wonder, doesn't it? Kirk out.
